- 1.** Will the proposed trees be planted in Australia?

- 2.** Are you a community group or organisation, school or other educational facility, sporting club, gardening club, Landcare group, environmental group or other not-for-profit?

**Yes** — you are eligible to proceed with your application

- 3.** Will the species you plant: Be indigenous to your region and Supply floral resources with nectar or pollen rewards continually across the calendar year?

- 4.** Will your proposed planting increase awareness among community members or the general public regarding the importance of planting for pollinators?
